When our members get urgent medical care at Kingsbridge Hospital, you're covered for between €75 and €375 of the cost of the consultation and treatment during your hospital visit.

The amount of cover depends on your scheme, which you can check any time in your Laya App or in the Member Area of layahealthcare.ie. We want to ensure you can always get the care you need so we don't place any cap on visits. You'll be covered every time you visit the hospital.

How much do you pay at the clinic on the day?

On average, laya healthcare members pay €45 out of pocket for a hospital visit. You can see the list of hospital fees and treatment costs below.

Please note: Kingsbridge hospital will charge the Sterling equivalent at the time of your presentation.

Consultations:

- Initial consultation €140
- Follow-up consultation (within 72 hours - same condition) €70
- Nurse consultation (wound dressing etc) €35
- Follow-up consultation (after 72 hours - same condition) €70
- Nurse consultation (wound dressing etc) €35

Additional Treatments:

- X-ray €100 (per x-ray)
- MRI scan (Covered by laya directly)
- Sutures/Clips/Skin Adhesive €50
- Full cast €60
- Temporary cast €35
- Splints €10-€50
- Crutches €35
- Walking boot €50
- Walking shoe €35
- Arm sling €15
- Long knee brace €95
- Short knee brace €80
- Hand positioning brace €100

What we don't treat:

- ✗ Pregnancy-related issues

- ✗ Vomiting requiring IV fluids
- ✗ Overdose, poisoning or attempted suicide
- ✗ Severe headache
- ✗ Severe abdominal pain
